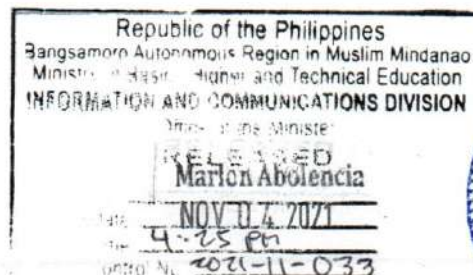

1. The Higher Education in the Context of the Bangsamoro Organic Law (HECBOL) Project of the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) supports the coordinating efforts of multiple government agencies and other stakeholders in attaining the objectives of assistance in terms of capacity building for the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education's (MBHTE) Higher Education subsector.
2. The MBHTE-Higher Education faces challenges in enhancing human capital stock and developing local human resource to address the need of local and global economies. Hence, efforts to revitalize tertiary education is necessary by attuning the competencies of the faculty.
3. This is timely and relevant to determine action points of BARMM Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) and as part of needs assessment, a series of training and workshops shall be conducted to further enhance and provide wide arrays of opportunity and productivity to the involved participants. Consequently, the following are the list of activities to be conducted:
 - a. Workshops on research writing
 - b. Professional English Speaking and writing workshops
 - c. Workshops on the preparation of journal articles and posters.

In this connection, the ministry's Directorate General for Higher Education, in coordination with CHED through HECBOL Project, will be conducting a **Workshop Series for BARMM HEIs Faculty: Capacitating Workforce towards a responsive and transformative BARMM HEIs)** on **November 15-19, 2021** at Dusit Thani Hotel, Davao City.
5. The University of Southeastern Philippines (USEP) will be the lead training provider and will manage the implementation. For Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) and sustainability, other resources like experts and HEIs linkages both local and international will also be part of training management.
6. Said activity has the following objectives:
 - a. Equip the BARMM HEIs faculty members with skills on scientific research writing, gathering data, and presenting research studies.
 - b. Develop among faculty the skills on English communication.
 - c. Develop an appreciation of the importance of research and communication in today's context.
