SUBJECT : **SUBMISSION OF IDENTIFIED ISAL SUBJECT WRITERS OF ADAPTIVE  
 LEARNING MATERIALS**

DATE : November 4, 2021

1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education, through the Directorate General for Madaris Education, shall be conducting a **Workshop on the Adaptive Learning Materials (ALMs) for Islamic Studies and Arabic Language (ISAL) subjects from Tahderiyah to Grade 6.**
2. Said activity aims to:
  - a. gain a better understanding of the details of the ALMs;
  - b. develop ALMs for ISAL subjects, quarter 2-4, for T-6 learners; and
  - c. make sure that the ALMs to be developed/enhanced are appropriate to the desired learning objectives.

4. The identified writer must be preferably an Arabic Language learned individual, but in case of the absence of such, teachers who have experienced writing ALMs shall be qualified.
